Bring my soul out of prison, O Lord, that I may praise Your Name”. Francis of Assisi closed his lips forever: he went into eternity singing. Saint Francis died October the 4<sup>th</sup> 1226. As a final greeting to the devoted singer of God’s praises, his good friends the larks came to sing their last farewell.
